High Altar Because the altar platform has to be in position for the service this afternoon (see below), the 10.00am Eucharist this morning will be celebrated at the Nave Altar, rather than the High Altar which is our custom during Lent.

Lent Lunch Today at 12noon, we offer the second of our simple Lent Lunches (17, 24 March, 7 April). The Revd Joachim Reich is the guest speaker at this lunch. Tickets are available from Rita Banfield. The money raised is donated to charity.

Lent Booklet This year's Lent Booklet follows the Church of England theme of "Lent Pilgrim". It is available on the Literature Table, or as a PDF on our website. Accompanied by the saints, we undertake a virtual pilgrimage from the Cathedral to the Cross. The booklet also includes helpful information about Lent lunches, stations of the cross, reading Mark right through, the film screening of King of Kings, and Holy Week and Easter Day services.

Service of Celebration This afternoon at 3.30pm, there is a special Eucharist to celebrate the 25th anniversary of the Ordination of women to the priesthood, which took place in Bristol Cathedral on 12 March 1994. The Revd Robbin Clark will preside, and the Bishop of Bristol will preach. All are invited to attend the service to mark this important occasion.
