TODAY

Stations of the Cross This afternoon at 3.30pm, walk the Via Dolorosa, (or if you prefer, remain seated in the nave), as we retrace the Stations of the Cross. Music from the Cathedral Choir. The service concludes with a moving dance drama from the Bristol School of Dancing.

HOLY WEEK

Tuesday in Holy Week, 5.15pm, *Membra Jesu Nostrī*, sung by The Fitzhardinge Consort
This meditative service takes at its heart the cantata cycle by Buxtehude, which is a contemplation of the parts of the body of the crucified Christ. It lasts just under an hour. This service, and the one on Wednesday, take place in the Eastern Lady Chapel.

Wednesday in Holy Week, 7.30pm, Compline, sung by the back row
This traditional plainsong night office is bookended by Thomas Tallis's exquisite *Lamentations of Jeremiah*. This service, and the one on Tuesday, take place in the Eastern Lady Chapel.

10.30am, Diocesan Eucharist, with the Bishop of Bristol preaching
7.30pm, The Liturgy of the Last Supper, with the Dean preaching

Good Friday

10.00am, The Meaning of the Cross, a service for children
12noon, Meditations at the Cross, with the Revd Dr Stephen Hampton, Dean of Peterhouse, Cambridge, preaching
1.30pm, The Liturgy of the Lord's Death

Holy Saturday

9.00pm, The Liturgy of the Lord's Resurrection, with confirmations. The Bishop presides.

Easter Day

10.00am, Festival Eucharist of the Resurrection of Our Lord, with the Dean preaching
3.30pm, Festal Evensong, with the Revd Sarah Evans preaching
