

Bristol Cathedral offers themed Education Days, developed and led by our Education Team; Frances Taylor and Fiona Dorman, qualified teachers, along with a team of enthusiastic volunteers.

These offer a unique opportunity for children to work alongside other school groups in a shared learning experience. Most of our education days follow a carousel format, allowing pupils to experience a variety of workshops in different parts of the cathedral. We usually return to the nave at the end of the day for a final plenary and celebration.





Bookings: Please complete a booking form to secure your place. The numbers on education days are limited and booking is on a first come first served basis.

Lunch: We provide a space for you to have lunch, but ask that you try to keep the cathedral as clean and tidy as possible. Schools may prefer to use College Green in fine weather.

Café: We have a small cathedral café selling hot and cold drinks and lunches.

Coach drop off point: Deanery Road, outside the central library.

The main cathedral entrance is off College Green.

Access: Please advise us of any wheelchair users so we can accommodate your needs.

Toilets: We have 6 toilets available next to our café, which are used by members of the public. For large events, we may provide portable toilets for use by school groups.
